How to use **ASAHI** Flash Gun the Strong Lamna

The **ASAHI** Flash Gun has been designed in such a manner that nobody would find it difficult to operate it. It is recommendable, however, that you should read the note described on the right hand below and use the item paying attentions to the marks.

SHUT

The outlet for kodak cord and compour cord (both are double cord)

EXT

The outlet for extention

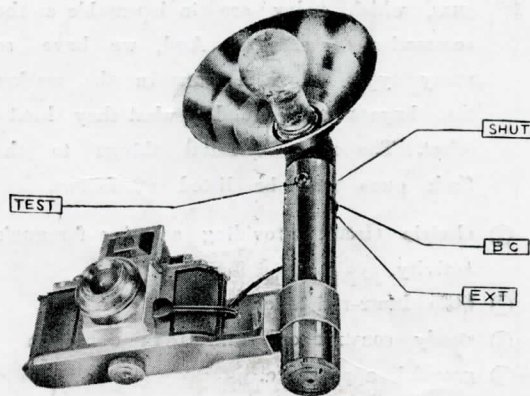
TEST

The device by which electric circuits are checked with the test lamp by means of pushing centra button

B C

When using laminated-battery the capacitor (condenser) and then the laminated battery (22.5V) are inserted, the botton-screw is screwed up and the switch is turned on by means of moving the thumb along in the direction of ON above the mark of BC

For caution's sake, you have to check the electric circuits with the test lamp (around 4~6V 200mA) for the laminated battery, prior to the practical use



As soon as you have finished, pull the switch down in the direction of OFF and shut off the current.

Since the ordinary batteries do nothing with this device you will be free in using them.
